"We need to bring learning to people instead of people to learning."



Victorious Kidss Educares always believes in building the bond between parents-children, peers, teacher- child, which are the emotional connections with wordless communication.

The purpose to have the parent -child-teacher activities on Saturdays is to build a secure attachment bond, so that your child feels secured, understood and safe which would result in an eagerness to learn through this new way and also give the

parents some fun time with their kids. The Junior KG, Senior KG and PYP 1, had played a few games and danced together.

Junior KG team- The class started with freeze dance followed by a doodle art by the parents and the kids and coloured it. Later the parent had to make a crown for their child.



Senior KG team – It started with a rhyme "Hello Hello ...Clap your hands", which encouraged the parent and the child to perform the actions together. Parents then played a game "KNOW YOUR CHILD" where they were asked questions and then both drew and saw whether it was correct. For example -Draw your child's favourite food, favourite toy etc. It ended with a dough making activity, wherein children and parents created artistic things like planets, snowman, boat, gingerbread and spoke about it.

PYP 1 – The class started with vegetable printing, children made creative drawings. They then played the game 'dumb-charades'. The teacher wrote words as 'mobile', 'pencil', 'tree' which the parents had to enact and children had to guess the object. Thereafter, they had fun during the funny freeze dance session as well.



All the sessions were filled with fun and enthusiasm where the toddlers learnt to create new things with their parents and the teachers further making the bond stronger.
